GOES IN

CARDBOARD: boxes, packaging, greeting cards

PAPER: newspaper, magazines, brochures, junk mail, Yellow Pages, directories, catalogues, envelopes, office paper & books

CANS & TINS: food, drink & pet food (they must be clean!)

PLASTICS: milk, drink, shampoo, detergent & other plastic bottles. Remove tops & put in separately. Containers for yoghurt, spreads, margarine etc.

ALUMINIUM: clean food containers & foil



REMEMBER: WASH IT, SQUASH IT AND PUT IT IN LOOSE.

Also

Computers and all other Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE), including hairdryers, mp3 players, electronic toothbrushes - (everything apart from musical ties, socks and cuddly toys!) can be recycled at all Household Waste sites.

STAYS OUT!

Shredded paper
Sweet papers
Waxed paper
Crisp packets
Cellophane
Polystyrene cups, containers & packaging
Plastic food wrap/cling film
Tetra Paks *
Plastic bags *
* Tetra Packs and plastic carriers can be recycled at Household Waste sites in Hadleigh or Sudbury.

Food waste

Fabric and shoes
